

ODISHA JOINT ENTRANCE EXAMINATION (OJEE) - 2017

NOTICE FOR SPOT COUNSELING OF BAMS/BHMS

The spot counselling for admission to BAMS/BHMS courses in the academic session 2017-18 is scheduled to hold at **OJEE CELL, Gandamunda, Bhubaneswar** on **30.10.2017, 31.10.2017**. The seats available in different colleges will be notified in website www.ojee.nic.in in due time along with time schedule for reporting of candidates.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. All **registered** OJEE BAMS/BHMS rank holder candidates are eligible to participate.
2. The candidates must be of **17 years** of age as on **31.12.2016**.
3. The parents of candidates must be permanent native of Odisha. Every candidate has to produce **Resident / Nativity certificate (Form No.-III, See Rule-3 of Govt. of Odisha)** during certificate verification.
4. The candidate must have passed +2 Sc. and in the subjects of **Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English** individually and must have secured minimum of 50% marks taken together in **Physics, Chemistry & Biology** at +2 Sc. level for General Candidate (GE). This minimum mark is 40% for SC/ST candidates.

DRAFT AND CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENT DURING CENTRAL COUNSELLING:

1. The candidate has to deposit a nonrefundable demand draft of Rs. 5000/- towards counselling fee In favour of "OJEE - 2017" drawn on any Scheduled Bank payable at Bhubaneswar, at the time of document verification and provisional allotment/admission at OJEE CELL Gandamunda, Bhubaneswar. Candidates who have already taken admission in online counselling need not pay any fee to participate in spot counselling.
2. The **relevant documents** of the candidate will be verified.
Originals will be verified and one set of self-attested photocopy has to be submitted.
 - i. OJEE rank card
 - ii. 10th board certificate and mark sheet ©
 - iii. +2 Sc. pass certificate and mark sheet ©
 - iv. College/School leaving certificate
 - v. Nativity/Resident certificate of Odisha(Form-III, See Rule-3 of Govt. of Odisha) ©**Nativity / Resident certificate is required for all candidates seeking admission to the course.**
 - vi. SC/ST Certificate by birth issued by competent authority, Government of Odisha (See Rule-8(I))
 - vii. Green Card issued by Family Welfare Dept. Govt. of OdishaPC medical board result is displayed in website. Only they can avail PC quota. Rajya Sainik Board has submitted the eligible Ex serviceman candidate list to OJEE, they are eligible to avail ES quota.

If any vacancy will arise after reporting of allotted candidates in the respective institutes, this counselling will be done. Vacant seats available will be declared on 29-10-2017, after receiving the reporting status of candidates in their allotted institutes in the website. But during central counselling, if any seat is released due to readmission by an admitted candidate, the seat released, will be displayed. This seat will be available to the candidates at that point of time only.

GUIDELINES:

1. Admission will be done strictly as per merit.
2. Candidates willing to participate in this round of counselling should report at counselling hall in the schedule time as per his/her category/rank. Only one person (guardian) will be allowed with the candidate to the counselling hall.
3. Candidates have to put their signature in an attendance sheet at the sitting hall.
4. Candidates coming after the schedule time will be allotted a seat/college from the balance seats available at that point of time taking merit into consideration.
5. Provisional allotment/ admission will be done at the venue of spot counselling. The candidate must bring all the original certificates.
6. Candidate has to deposit required fees at the counselling spot positively, failing which no allotment will be made and candidature will be rejected.
7. Undertaking of any kind shall not be allowed.
8. Once seats are filled up, admission will be closed. Presence in the venue does not ensure seat. Seats are allotted based on merit to the present candidates.
9. Category change in the same institute is not allowed.
